Responsibilities	Responsible with the Lead Mentor for the overall wellbeing and safety of participants in participant-led (usually children!), inquiry based programs. A full job description will be provided to candidates at an interview
Skills	You possess many skills, but, the essentials for this role include: excellent communication including timely questioning & peppering of factual information, great teamwork and ability to follow instructions, an eye for safety, sound decision making, attention to detail, excellent story telling, and the ability to have fun & play.
